Railing & Deck Frames

CLEANING

A. Dirt and Debris – To remove dirt and debris, use clean water and soap, rinse with water. Do NOT use acid solutions, steel wool, or other harsh abrasives.

MAINTENANCE

- A. Periodically check for any loose parts, such as screws or railing pickets.
- B. If chips or scratches are found in the powder coat surface, use a similar color enamel touch up paint (either spray or liquid).

Decking

CLEANING

- A. Dirt and Debris Clean deck to remove dirt and debris. Soap and water is generally all that is needed. An eco-friendly cleaner called Citadel's Eco Cleaner is also available directly from Citadel Coatings. Phone 866-765-4310 or www.citadelfloors.com. Do NOT use acid solutions, bleach, steel wool, or other harsh abrasives.
- B. Ice and Snow Use a plastic shovel, NOT a metal shovel to remove ice and snow. Apply calcium chloride to melt ice. Rinse off debris when first practical.
- C. Oil & Grease Stains Rinse the stain with hot water as soon as possible.
- D. Mold & Mildew Semi-annual (spring and fall) cleaning of the deck is important to prevent the buildup of pollen and other debris that can support the growth of mold.

MAINTENANCE

A. If chips or scratches are found in the powder coat surface, use a similar color enamel touch up paint (either spray or liquid).
