As announced in the 2016-17 Budget, our Government is currently reviewing all our programs, initiatives and expenditures to make certain that they continue to meet their objectives and contribute to a strong province. In conducting this review, it is our intention to examine whether our current programs and services are still necessary, are sustainable for the long-term, and are being delivered in the most efficient and effective manner for the people of Saskatchewan.

This review process is also considering our sources of revenue to examine their adequacy to fund the services Saskatchewan people value, the composition and balance between our revenue sources, and whether there are opportunities to simplify administration for taxpayers and businesses.
